He loved showing his animals and participating in 4H events as often as he could. He won many awards and buckles during his short time in the show ring. To honor his life and love for 4H, his family created the Ashton Bray Memorial Scholarship Foundation. This non-profit foundation is dedicated to supporting FFA and 4H students in their academic futures. A total of \$44,000 has been awarded in the form of \$1000 scholarships since 2012. Although donations may be made throughout the year, the primary fundraiser is the Ashton Bray Memorial BBQ and Auction held annually the first Friday in December.
