2023 National Junior Tarentaise Virtual Show Rules and Guidelines

- 1. The exhibitor must be a current Junior member of the American Tarentaise Association.
- The show will consist of 5 classes: Purebred/Fullblood Heifers, Purebred/Fullblood Bulls, Market Steers, and Commercial Heifers.
- 3. All animals entered in the breeding classes must be registered as Fullblood or Purebred with the American Tarentaise Association in the exhibitor's name and/or be owned by the exhibitor's family on or before July 1, 2023.
- 4. Bulls and Heifers must be born between September 1, 2021 and December, 31, 2022
- 5. Market Steers should be 50% or greater Tarentaise breeding. Steers and will be judged as market ready for a 2023 late summer harvest date. A declared weight will be required at the time of entry.
- 6. Commercial Heifers should be 50% or greater Tarentaise breeding. Please provide parental documentation to validate percentages.
- 7. Junior Bulls/Heifers/Steers must be born between January 1, 2023 and May 1, 2023 and shown by exhibitors 6-12 years old as of January 1 2023
- 8. Pre-Entries are to be submitted to the American Tarentaise Junior Associations via email or mail between June 20-July 5, 2023.
- 9. Video Entries are to be submitted between June 20th-July 5, 2023 with winners being announced the evening of the summer meeting on July 15th.
- 10. Please use the following video requirements when videoing your animals for the show using the following video as a guide for how to set up and present your animal.

VIDEO REQUIREMENTS

- The focus should be on the animal, not the exhibitor.
 However, at some point in the video you must include a shot of the exhibitor and the animal with the exhibitors face visible.
- Please show all views and angles of the animal.
- Your animal must be clean.
- Fit your animal as if you were going into the live show ring.
- Appropriate show attire must be worn NO HATS or FFA/4-H/ASSOCIATION ATTIRE may be worn by the exhibitor.
- No previous awards, banners, etc. may be in the background of the video. Belt Buckles can be worn.
- Do not state your name, club, breeder or any details about your project. No talking is permitted in the submitted video.

- All videos must be between 60 and 90 seconds, no more than 4GB, and submitted in a the horizontal 16x9 aspect ratio. (simply rotate your phone to "Landscape Mode" - see explainer image below.)
- Do not alter the raw video by placing any overlays, etc.



11. <u>A still profile photo of the show side of the animal will also need to be submitted at the time</u> <u>of video entry.</u> Please use a camera height of 5ft with the animal set up approximately 12-15ft from the camera.
